The Academic Library Association (ALA) has started its functioning during 2013 and it became an official entity on 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014 as registered society according to the Travancore-Cochin, Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act 1955.

During the period 2022-2023 the ALA conducted the following major programmes:

- 2. **Annual General Body Meeting of the Academic Library Association**: The Annual General Body meeting of the Academic Library Association 2021-22 was held online on 16-03-2022.
- 3. **School Libraries**: ALA is taking all efforts to establish libraries in schools, especially in Kerala State Schools and urged the state governments to establish good libraries in all schools and appoint qualified librarians with provision for library hours.
- 4. **UGC Scheme for all College Librarians**: As envisaged in the UGC Scheme, the meeting also decided to represent the UGC, Govt. of India, State Governments and Universities to implement the UGC Scheme for librarians and provide academic status for librarians.
- 5. **UGC Librarians in all Universities and Colleges:** The meeting requested to sanction UGC Librarians in all colleges and universities.
- 6. **Recruitment to Universities**: It also decided to represent the State and Central Governments, UGC and recruiting agencies to fill up all vacant posts of library professionals in all colleges and universities in India.

Swapna, Dr. P.A. Pradeep, Dr. Susan Mathew, Dr. Joshy George, Ms. Neetha Devan, Ms. Neethu Mohanan, Dr. Joseph I. Thomas, Dr. B. Engango, etc.

- 14. Representation to Govt. of Kerala: ALA submitted detailed representations to the Govt. of Kerala on: (i). To speed up the direct recruitment of Library/Professional Assistants to universities by KPSC; (ii). To implement the UGC Scheme for librarians in government arts and science colleges; and medical, Ayurveda, nursing, engineering and poly technique colleges; (iii). To sanction the post of librarian in all schools under state government and post qualified librarians; (iv). To sanction start Full-Time Libraries in all Local Bodies and sanction the post of Qualified Librarian.
- 15. **Representation to KUHS**:- ALA submitted detailed representations to the Kerala University of Health Sciences stressing the need for revamping the Library System, Services and Professionals in the University and colleges under it.
- 16. **Membership Campaign:** The ALA Committee and members have done continuous efforts to enroll more library professionals as members of the association. During this period, 52 new professionals enrolled as ALA Life Members and the total members rose from 833 to 885 as on 10-03-2023.
- 17. **Assets as on 10-03-2023:** As on 10-03-2023, Rs. 89,608/- has been deposited as FD in the State of Bank of India, Ollukara, Thrissur branch towards the Life Membership Fee till collected.
- 18. Annual General Body Meeting: We have decided to conduct the National Seminar on Role of Libraries in Academic Research and Publishing in collaboration with the Rajagiri Business School, Kakkanad, Kochi and Kerala College Librarians Association. The Annual General Body Meeting and Election 2023 also will be held on 10-03-2023.
- 19. Project on Reading, Library and Excellence in Science:- ALA in collaboration with NASI and other government and non-govt. agencies started a project to organize seminars, workshops, discussions, trainings, etc. in universities, colleges and schools.
