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Annual Report of the Indian Academic Library Association (ALA) For the Period April 2025 – March 2026 Presented at the Annual General Body Meeting held online on 26-05-2026

Annual Report of the Indian Academic Library Association (ALA) for the period **01 April 2025 – 31st March 2026** is given below:

The ALA was initially formed on 1st November 1996. The Association secured registration under the Travancore-Cochin, Literary, Scientific and Charitable Societies Registration Act 1955 on 31st March 2014 with Reg. No. TSR/TC/267/2014.

ALA is particularly interested in establishing a robust school library system because school libraries serve as the foundation for the development of a successful reading culture in society, which in turn serves as the basis for the expansion and development of all library types, including academic, special, and public libraries.

The ALA carried out the following significant programmes during the period 2025–2026:

2. **Annual General Body Meeting of the Academic Library Association:** - The Annual General Body meeting of the Academic Library Association 2024-25 was held online on 14-05-2025.
3. **Annual General Body Meeting 2025-26:-** The Annual General Body meeting of the Academic Library Association 2025-26 is scheduled to be held online on 26-05-2026, 8.30 pm online.
4. **School Libraries:** - ALA is taking all efforts to establish libraries in schools, especially in Kerala State Schools and urged the state governments to establish good libraries in all schools and appoint qualified professional librarians with provision for syllabus based compulsory library hours for Library Education.
5. **UGC Scheme for all College Librarians:** - As envisaged in the UGC Scheme, the meeting also decided to represent the UGC, Govt. of India, State Governments and Universities to implement the UGC Scheme for librarians and provide academic status for librarians.
6. **Re-designation of Library Professionals:-** The meeting urged the Governments, UGC and Professional Councils in India to take action to re-designate the nomenclature of Library Professionals as suggested below:
 - a. Library Education Teacher: In Schools
 - b. Asst. Professor, Associate Professor and Professor in Colleges
 - c. Asst. Professor, Associate Professor, Professor and Director / Dean Libraries in Universities
7. **UGC Librarians in all Universities and Colleges:-**The meeting discussed the issue of vacant position of University Librarians for several decades in Kerala and noted that some universities not even created this important post. All Government colleges in Kerala, except 12 are running without UGC qualified librarians. The meeting urged the universities, UGC and Govts. to sanction UGC Librarians in all colleges and universities.
8. **Recruitment to Universities:** - ALA has taken earnest efforts to fill up the vacant posts of library professionals in all colleges and universities in India. The Association through formal and informal efforts taken strong actions and filled most of the vacant posts of Professional Assistants in universities in Kerala.
9. **Endowment towards ALA Award:-** Prof. (Dr.) A.T. Francis, Professor & Head and Chief Librarian, Dept.

of Library and Research Documentation, Amala Institute of Medical Sciences, Thrissur, Kerala and President, ALA and Prof. (Dr.) S. Humayoon Kabir, Former Professor & Head, DLIS, University of Kerala and Executive Committee Member of ALA offered during March 2024 Rs. 3.00 Lakhs and Rs. 1.00 Lakhs respectively for instituting an Endowment Fund towards ALA Award and for investing the same in Shares and Mutual Funds as per Govt. of India Regulations. During March 2025, Dr. K.R. Ajithan, Former Chief Librarian, Govt. Victoria College, Palakkad has offered Rs. 40,000/- towards the Award Endowment Fund. The ALA Executive Committee decided to Top-Up the Fund by Rs. 50,000/-

10. Investment of ALA Award Endowment:- Rs. 4.50 Lakhs, contributed to the ALA Award Endowment Fund has been invested in selected 49 Indian Stocks through the De-mat Account No. A18QS in Kodak – Sharewealth Securities Ltd., Thrissur. Though we have received Rs. 6534.69 as Dividend from these shares during 2024-26, the overall performance of the shares were not good due to the reduction in share price indices due to War and other reasons world over.

11. ALA Best Librarian Awards:- ALA Awards are presenting from 2018 onwards. But, it is decided to present 03 Awards from 2025 onwards, (1). One Best Librarian–Life Time Achievement Award with a Cash Award of Rs. 20,000/-, Citation and a Certificate; and (2) Two National Librarian Awards with Citation and a Certificate, but without Cash Award. It was also decided to present at least one of three awards to a professional from out of Kerala. Accordingly, 2025 Awards were presented as per this decision.

12. Increase the ALA Best Librarian Awards:- The Executive Committee of the Indian Academic Library Association decided to present 04 Awards from 2026 onwards, (1). One Best Librarian–Life Time Achievement Award with a Cash Award of Rs. 20,000/-, Citation and a Certificate; and (2) Three National Librarian Awards with Citation and a Certificate, with or without Cash Award. For the year 2026, the ALA has mobilized fund for the Cash Prize for National Librarian Awards @ Rs. 5,000/- and to continue this practice if financially possible.

13. ALA Librarian Awards 2025 Onwards:-

From the year 2026 onwards, the Titles of ALA Librarian Awards have been modified as follows:

- (i). **ALA National Best Librarian–Lifetime Achievement Award (01 No) with a Cash Award of Rs. 20,000/-; and**
- (ii). **ALA National Best Librarian Award (03 Nos.) with or without Cash Prize. For the year 2026, the prize money was Rs. 5,000/- each.**

ALA decided to present 03 ALA National Best Librarian Awards from 2026 onwards. Out of these four Awards, at least one award will be presented to an Out of Kerala Professional.

Colleges like Carmel College (Autonomous), Mala, Little Flower College (Autonomous), Guruvayur, Union Christian, College, Aluva, Ernakulam, etc. Prof. Dr. A.T. Francis, Professor and Head, and Chief Librarian, Dept. of Library & Research Documentation, Amala Institute of Medical Sciences. Sri. Abdul Razak, Former University Librarian, KAU, Dr. K.R. Ajithan, Former Chief Librarian, Govt. Victoria College, Palakkad, Kerala, Dr. V.S. Swapna, Librarian, College of Agriculture, etc. were handled major sessions.
21. **Representation to Govt. of Kerala**: - ALA submitted detailed representations to the Govt. of Kerala on:(i). To speed up the direct recruitment of Library/Professional Assistants to universities by KPSC; (ii). To implement the UGC Scheme for librarians in government arts and science colleges; and medical, Ayurveda, nursing, engineering and poly technique colleges; (iii). To sanction the post of librarian in all schools under state government and post qualified librarians; (iv). To sanction start Full-Time Libraries in all Local Bodies and sanction the post of Qualified Librarian.
22. **Membership Campaign**:-The ALA Committee and members have done continuous efforts to enroll more library professionals as members of the association. During the period of 2025-26, 128 new professionals enrolled as ALA Life Members and the total members rose from 1072 to 1200 as on 31-03-2026.
23. **Assets as on 31-03-2026**:- As on 31-03-2026, ALA has Fixed Deposit of Rs. 99,879/- towards the Life Membership Fee collected and Rs. 43222.06 in Savings Deposit in State of Bank of India, Ollukara, Thrissur Branch, and Rs. 21740.68 as Cash in Hand.
24. **Major Donations**:- During the period from April 2025 to March 2026, we have received one major donation from M/s. Drillbit (Rs. 20,000/-), and three other donations during April and May 2026 from Ms. K.R. Surekha (Rs. 6,000/-); Dr. Smitha Elayidam (Rs. 10,000/-) and Dr. P. Muthumari (Rs. 5,000/-).
